

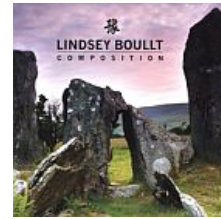
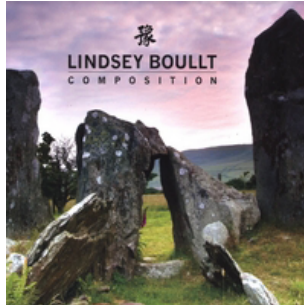
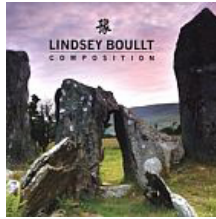

USA guitarist and composer Lindsey Boullt is a respectable and well-known artist. For his second effort entitled "Composition", he formed a representative team of collaborators, all of them are surely some kind of legends, (Jerry Goodman, Derek Sherinan, Stu Hamm, Atma Atur, Sukhawat Ali Khan, Peter Van Gelder...), and recorded an album with whom he can be absolutely proud.

On 10 offering themes "Composition" announce some sort of journey through 70's period till nowadays, where elements of fusion, jazz-rock, progressive, equally communicate with many actual electronic additions, and crossover parts.

Influences come out from Mahavishnu Orchestra kitchen aren't mentioned only for presence of Jerry Goodman on album, they are clear, but also are fullfield with modern intentions, and well done production. Arrangements are colourful, but each of offering theme also possesses often rhythm changes, atmospheric challenges, and conceptual movements.

"Composition" hardly needs a strong attention, but a whole album is worth of each minute of mentioned listener's time. In modern way "Composition" sublime musical sequences come out from different ethno fields, where special places take Middle East and Arabia, as a main inspiration. Finally, "Composition" is an album full of creativities and imaginations, with respectable valuabilities.
